The word of the Eternal came to Jonah son of Amittai:

רְעִתָּם לִפְנֵי:¹

“Go at once to Nineveh, that great city, and proclaim judgment upon it; for their wickedness has come before me.” Jonah, however, fled from God’s service. He found a ship going to Tarshish, paid the fare, and went aboard. But God cast a mighty wind upon the sea, and such a great tempest arose that the ship was in danger of breaking up.

The ship's crew said to one another, “Let us cast lots and find out on whose account this misfortune has come upon us.” The lot fell on Jonah, and they said to him, “Tell us, what is your business? Where have you come from? What is your country, and of what people are you?” Jonah responded,

The men asked, "What must we do to you to make the sea calm around us?" For the sea was growing more and more stormy. He answered, "Heave me overboard, and the sea will calm down for you." They did, and the sea calmed.

God provided a great fish to swallow Jonah; and Jonah remained in the fish's belly three days and three nights. Jonah prayed to his God from the belly of the fish. He said:

God commanded the fish, and it spewed Jonah out upon dry land. God's word came to Jonah a second time: "Go at once to Nineveh, that great city, and proclaim to it what I tell you." Jonah went at once to Nineveh in accordance with God's command. He said, "Forty days more, and Nineveh shall be overthrown!" The people of Nineveh believed God. The king proclaimed a fast, and great and small alike put on sackcloth. He had the word cried through Nineveh: "By decree of the king and his nobles:

“No human or beast — of flock or herd — shall taste anything! They shall not graze, and they shall not drink water! They shall be covered with sackcloth — human and beast — and shall cry mightily to God.” God saw what they did, how they were turning back from their evil ways, and God renounced the punishment.

This displeased Jonah greatly. He prayed to God, saying, “O God! That is why I fled to Tarshish. I know that you are a compassionate and gracious God, slow to anger, abounding in kindness, renouncing punishment. Please,

Outside the city, Jonah made a sukkah and sat in its shade, until he should see what happened. God provided a plant, which grew up over Jonah to provide shade for his head. Jonah was very happy about the plant. But the next day God provided a worm, which attacked the plant so that it withered. When the sun rose, God provided a sultry east wind; the sun beat down on Jonah’s head, and he became faint. He begged for death, saying, “I would rather die than live.” Then God said to Jonah, “Are you so deeply grieved about the plant?” “Yes,” he replied, “so deeply that I want to die.” Then God said:

Is there another God like you — pardoning iniquity, annulling transgression? God does not hold fast endless anger, for God desires steadfast love. God will take us back, will have compassion for us, and will subdue our iniquities. You will be true and faithful to Israel, granting steadfast love to the descendants of Abraham and Sarah — as you swore to our ancestors in days of old.

הקדמה Introduction

THE HEBREW WORD *avodah* means both service in the sense of action and a service of prayer. The *Avodah* service is unlike any other prayer service in Jewish tradition. Instead of a series of prayers and meditations, this service consists entirely of the dramatic description of the most ancient Yom Kippur rituals practiced by our ancestors in the Temple in Jerusalem. These rituals have not been performed literally for almost 2,000 years, and they are radically different from the Judaism we practice today. But by reliving the awesome experience of the High Priest, we connect ourselves to a chain of tradition that reminds us where we stand today: at a liminal moment, an opportunity for personal and communal transformation, an opportunity for *teshuvah*. So as we all imagine ourselves as the High Priest for just a moment, we also ask, “What *Avodah* — what service — remains for us in the waning hours of this Yom Kippur?”

OUR SAGES teach:

The world God made is holy.

Among the holy places in the world is the holy Land of Israel.

The holiest city in the Land of Israel is Jerusalem.

The holiest place in Jerusalem was the Temple.

And the holiest place in the Temple was the Holy of Holies.

There are seventy languages in the world.

Among the holy languages is Hebrew.

The holiest words in Hebrew are the words of the Torah.

The holiest utterances in the Torah

are the Ten Commandments,

And the holiest word in the Ten Commandments is the Name of God, made of four letters: yud-hei-vav-hei.

One word

On the lips of one person

In one place

At one moment

Brought together these dimensions of holiness:

When the High Priest enters the Holy of Holies on Yom Kippur

And utters the Name of God.

Wherever a person stands to lift up eyes to heaven,
that place is a Holy of Holies.

Every human being created by God
in God's own image is a High Priest.

Each day of a person's life is the Day of Atonement.

Each one of us can face God with the language of the heart.

Each one of us can be forgiven.

Each one of us can achieve atonement
and be made pure in the eyes of God.

ON YOM KIPPUR, within the Holy of Holies, the High Priest would speak words of confession — First for himself and his family; Then for the priests who served at his side; And, finally, for the whole community.

IN ORDER TO REPRESENT the community, the High Priest must be personally prepared. But he may only enter the Holy of Holies as an emissary of a holy community, not as a sole individual seeking atonement. And so it is with us: on this Yom Kippur, our personal paths to *teshuva*h and the path of our community are intertwined. We are here for each other in the personal work of atonement we do today. In striving to be our best selves, we can be better equipped to join as a community to perform acts of kindness and love.

WE BEGIN AT DAWN on the holy day. The morning horizon glowed before the gaze of the watchman. Behind a spread curtain of linen, to give him privacy, the High Priest removed his clothing and immersed in the *mikveh* — the first of five baths — then dressed himself in garments of gold. He stood, in a state of holiness, to begin the first offering; he kindled incense and lamps, brought forth sacrifice and libation. Having bathed again, he wore a white robe — an exquisite garment to serve the Sovereign of Glory.

Within the Holy of Holies, in holiness and purity, the High Priest spoke the four letters that form God's name — spoken only by him, and now all but lost to the ages. The people standing in the Temple Court heard the holy, glorious, awe-inspiring name, and they would bow towards the ground, saying, “*Baruch sheim — Praised is the name of the One whose glorious sovereignty will be forever and ever.*”

AFTER THE FIRST CONFESSION, the High Priest walked to the east, where two goats, alike in height and appearance, stood bound together in the Temple courtyard — bound there for the sake of atonement.

The priest cast golden lots, lifted one lot from the box, and lowered it to destine one goat for God high above and the other for the high mountain cliff. He tied crimson wool to the head of the goat to be sent into the wilderness. Then he returned to the sacrificial bull, confessing on behalf of all of the priests before the Eternal.

LET US NOW PRAISE the Sovereign of the universe, and proclaim the greatness of the Creator who has set us apart from the other families of the earth, giving us a destiny unique among the nations. We bend the knee and bow, acknowledging the supreme Sovereign, the Holy One of Blessing.

THE ANCIENT HIGH PRIEST performed his impressive ritual sequence in the Temple on Yom Kippur: he sent the goat out into the harsh desert; read aloud the Torah portions; spoke God's ineffable name; and confessed on behalf of himself, the priests, and all of God's people. Then, he would emerge joyously from the Holy of Holies and speak this prayer to all those assembled before him:
